- · Millions of emergency room visits every year are due to car accidents.
- More than 35,000 people were killed in auto accidents in 2015. (1)

IN 2015:

THERE WERE 374,522 TOTAL CAR ACCIDENTS IN FLORIDA.



159,859 OF THOSE CRASHES CAUSED INJURY, WITH 243,396 VICTIMS.



2,698 OF THOSE CRASHES WERE FATAL, WITH 2,938 TOTAL FATALITIES. (2)


