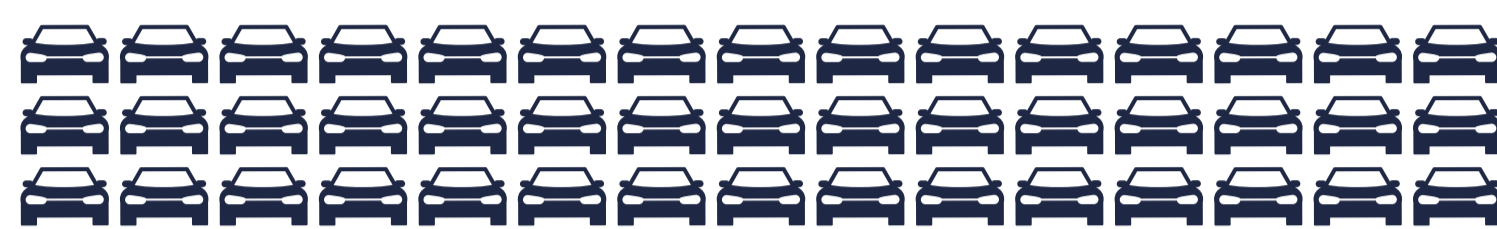
Nationwide, thousands of people
KILLED OR INJURED
in car accidents every day.



- Millions of emergency room visits every year are due to car accidents.
- More than 35,000 people were killed in auto accidents in 2015. (1)

IN 2015:

THERE WERE **374,522** TOTAL CAR ACCIDENTS IN FLORIDA.



159,859 OF THOSE CRASHES CAUSED INJURY, WITH **243,396** VICTIMS.



2,698 OF THOSE CRASHES WERE FATAL, WITH **2,938** TOTAL FATALITIES. (2)



ALCOHOL-IMPAIRED DRIVING

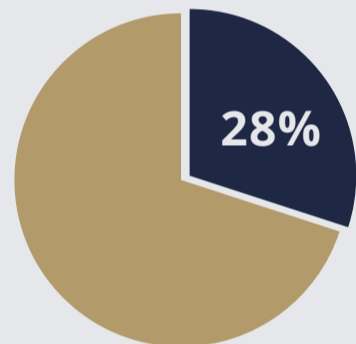
In one CDC study:



1.9% of drivers nationwide admitted to driving after drinking too much within the previous 30 days.



2.1% of Florida drivers admitted to driving after drinking too much in the same timeframe. (3)



In 2015, alcohol was involved in 676 traffic fatalities in Florida – 28% of all traffic deaths. (4)
